Easy Reels

## Tomato Crop Support and Plant Layering System

- ♦ **Two Piece unit** – **black nylon hanger** and replaceable white UV stabilised polypropylene **reel**.
- ♦ Reels are wound with up to **25 metres** UV stabilised polypropylene twine (1 year UV life).
- ♦ Hangers will **not spin** off the crop wire.
- ♦ **Clip** securing hanger on crop wire flexible to allow **quick** removal and refitting.
- ♦ Long lengths of twine are **easily** unwound.
- ♦ Only **one hand** is needed for layering – if plants are very heavy the other hand can be used to guide the plant.
- ♦ Reels **rotate** once to release short lengths of twine then **self-lock** on the hanger.
- ♦ **Eliminates** the need to **lift** each plant when layering.
- ♦ Reels **will not** fall off the hangers.
- ♦ Reels **self-lock** when any weight is hung from the twine.
- ♦ Reels are **easily** taken off the hangers at the end of the crop.
- ♦ A **new reel** can be fitted **mid-way** through a crop.
- ♦ The hanger is made from **nylon** for long life.

## How it works .....

### Unwinding long lengths of twine

For *efficiency*:  
Unwind the twine by pulling the twine off sideways  
...  
*or*  
the reel will freewheel if held upside down.



### Layering



To make layering *easier*:  
Grasp Reelenz easy-reels as shown. Squeeze between the thumb and middle finger to release the lock and then control the speed of the reel with the index finger. The reel will self-lock. Slide the hanger along the crop wire. *Either* hand can be used. If the plants are very heavy the *free* hand can be used to guide the plant.

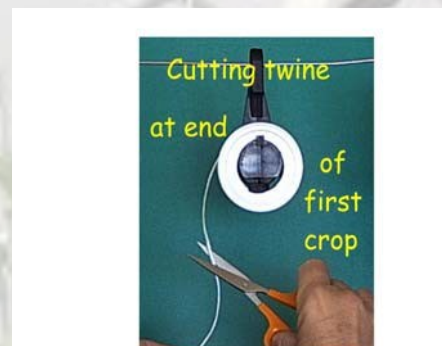


### At the end of the crop

*Either*: For *speed, economy and efficiency*:  
Cut the twine ready for the next crop.

*Or*: Turn the hanger upside down to allow the reel to freewheel and let the remaining twine off the reel.

*Or*: Lift the reel off the hanger and the remaining twine can be unwound off as the plants are being lowered to the ground. This way the hanger is ready for a replacement reel.



### Replacement reels

For *economy* replacement reels are available when the twine runs out.

### Fitting a new reel mid-way through a crop

A new reel can be fitted if the twine runs out mid-way through a crop. When the twine is about to run out, tie a simple knot around the old twine and slide this knot up to the knot already on the old twine.



## **REELENZ** Instructions for Use:

Fit the reel onto the hanger with the exposed twine (on the side of the reel) against the hanger, (to protect the exposed twine from the sun).

### **To release short lengths of twine:**

Place the thumb and index finger around the twine on the reel.  
Place the middle finger on the shoulder on the side of the hanger. Squeeze between the thumb and middle finger to release the lock. Control the speed of the reel with the index finger.

Either hand can be used.



### **To release longer lengths of twine:**

Unwind twine from the reel before fitting on to the hanger or  
Pull the twine sideways off the reel once fitted to the hanger or  
Hold Reelenz upside down to allow the reel to freewheel.

### **To fit a new reel midway through a crop:**

Tie a simple knot around the old twine and slide the knot up to the knot already on the old twine. Change the reels on the hanger or put the new reel onto a spare hanger. The old hanger then becomes the spare hanger.

### **At end of crop:**

reels are easily lifted off the hanger and the remaining twine pulled off *or alternatively* turn Reelenz upside down and let the reel freewheel.

**Note:** The hanger can be put on and taken off the crop wire easily as the clip is flexible enough to be pushed against the wire.
